

# Badminton Secondary Age Workshop

## Organiser Guidance Notes



The Badminton Secondary Age Workshop is designed to support and increase the confidence of those who are delivering badminton to 11-18 year olds as part of curriculum or extra-curricular sessions. The workshop combines introducing the Badminton Secondary Age resource which learners are given access to and how this can support the delivery of badminton with session plans, technical content and games ideas with practical experience of various hitting techniques.

<b>Length of workshop:</b>	4 hours (4.5 hours for courses with 13-16 learners)	
<b>Course content:</b>	<p>The workshop aims to introduce learners to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The secondary age resource and how to use it</li> <li>▪ Movement within badminton</li> <li>▪ The importance of grips within badminton</li> <li>▪ The technical key points of serving, underarm &amp; overhead hitting</li> <li>▪ Feeding to support session deliver</li> <li>▪ The STEPS principle and how to effectively use it</li> <li>▪ Match play &amp; tactics</li> <li>▪ Games ideas</li> </ul>	
<b>Tutor:</b>	Badminton England will provide a tutor who is appropriately trained and qualified in delivering this workshop	
<b>Minimum &amp; maximum number of candidates (for one tutor):</b>	8-16 candidates	
<b>Facilities required:</b>	Sports hall with 2- 3 courts in line with the facility checklist. <i>We operate a 1:6 court to learner ratio</i>	
<b>Equipment:</b> <i>To be provided by the organiser</i>	8 rackets – all other equipment will be provided by the tutor/ Badminton England.	
<b>Learners Equipment:</b>	Learners should be told to wear appropriate sports clothing and footwear.	
<b>Standard workshop cost:</b>	Up to 12 candidates £450.00	Up to 16 candidates £500.00
