

Badminton England – Safeguarding Training

Safeguarding training for coaches (and other roles within badminton)

UK Coaching Safeguarding and Protecting Children (SPC)

This course is the industry standard and most recognised of all safeguarding training in sport courses available. It is the recognised standard for Clubmark. This workshop should be revisited by attendees every 3 years in order that the learning is reinforced. All new coaches must attend this training in in order to validate their (Level 2) Club Coach qualification.

UK Coaching - Safeguarding and Protecting Children RENEWAL. * E learning.

This course is **only** to be used as a refresher to the SPC and the workshop must have been attended within the last 3 years to enable the online refresher option to be used. The online option may be used once only, once another 3 years has passed a direct delivered workshop must be attended.

This is a positive alternative to attending a workshop every 3 years as you can add on additional topics within the refresher according to your personal interest or role, these include: 'Digital Kids' 'Deaf and Disabled Children' and 'Positive Parents'

Badminton England online safeguarding training * E learning.

This is a new course and is a basic introduction to safeguarding suitable for anyone who wishes to promote positive behaviour with young people and adults at risk in badminton. As part of a drive to ensure all our coaches are safeguarding trained, we are making this course available free of charge for one year only from December 2021 to coaches as part of their club membership renewal **only for those coaches who have not completed SPC safeguarding training within the last 3 years.**

For other roles, particularly those with less direct contact with young people and adults at risk this course will be available at a cost of £15.

The training include signs of abuse, how to respond to a disclosure and safeguarding contacts within Badminton England.

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR ALL COACHES: Please note that this online training is a level below the UK Coaching SPC Course, therefore if you are an active coach working with young people and adults at risk within badminton, you should complete the SPC course every 3 years.

Badminton England delivered Time to Listen is available for Club and County Welfare Officers. It builds on the prior learning from SPC1 and so attendance at SPC1 is a pre requisite for attending this course.
