2022 U17 6 Nations - Provisional Selection

Following the Selection Panel meeting held on Wednesday 9th March 2022, please find below the individuals provisionally selected to compete in the upcoming 2022 U17 6 Nations. The Event is being hosted by the Dutch Badminton Association and is taking place in Arnhem from 14th 18th April 2022;

N.B The above denotes the discipline in which players were primarily selected in respect to the Selection Policy published and criteria noted within section 4 of this Policy. As per the Event Regulations, players will be considered for entry into additional disciplines in the Event as decided by 6 Nations Coaching Team.

Additional Selection to fulfil the Event Regulations

Further to selecting players aligned to the published criteria above, due to there being insufficient male players selected under the published criteria (requirement of a minimum of 6 players), the Panel considered players that then met the following to enable us to fulfil and send a Team to the Event (below as included within the Selection Policy, with the Panel referencing the additional considerations whilst doing so):

***'N.B** In exceptional circumstances, should the above criteria not provide the minimum number of players to fulfil a Team in line with the Event regulations (minimum of 6 male and 6 female), the Panel will consider reducing the specific result criteria to consider players who have met one result below the criteria published where these have not been considered within section 4 already i.e., where a semi-final is listed in the criteria, the Panel would then consider a quarter final result in that event. If this is required, the Panel will consider results one level lower under 4.1 first. If this does not provide sufficient players, the Panel will then consider players who have met one result level lower under 4.2 criteria, followed by 4.3 (if necessary).'*

In consideration of the above, the following players were then selected in order to fulfil the Event regulations and to provide the necessary cover for the Team Event, based on each Team Match being made up of 2BS, 2GS, 2BD, 2GD and 1XD match:
