

Badminton England Disciplinary Sanctions

In the interests of transparency, and as per Section 9 of the Badminton England Disciplinary Regulations, Badminton England publishes the decisions of all disciplinary and appeal hearing panels unless there are exceptional circumstances in which it is considered inappropriate to publish. Badminton England is permitted to publish any sanction imposed in a disciplinary process since the adoption of the Regulations (23 June 2021).

Sanction:

- A 24-month suspension from badminton in any capacity directly or indirectly under the jurisdiction of Badminton England. For clarity this would include all coaching and all playing.
- Cannot hold any positions of responsibility with a club, county, or leagues.
- Referral to the Disclosure and Barring Service.

Sanction:

- A written warning.
- A 12-month suspension from badminton in any capacity directly or indirectly under the jurisdiction of Badminton England. For clarity this includes all coaching and all playing.
- A referral to the Disclosure and Barring Service.

Name: Mervin Gibbs

Sanction:

- Permanent exclusion from badminton in any capacity directly or indirectly under the jurisdiction of Badminton England or any other national badminton governing body.
