England Senior Performance Programme Criteria & Review Process



1. Purpose of the England Senior Performance Programme Criteria

1.1. The purpose of the England Senior Performance Programme (EPP) criteria is to provide entry level performance requirements for players to be considered for, or retained, on EPP.

2. Entry level criteria for the England Performance Programme

- 2.1. To be considered by the Review Panel for inclusion on the EPP, a player will have met a minimum of 2 competition results as well as the additional requirements stated in the criteria.
- 2.2. Achievement of the criteria is a guideline does not guarantee inclusion on the EPP but triggers the Review Panel to discuss the player's individual development and possible opportunities to progress.
- 2.3. Criterion met because of walkovers and/or byes will be considered by the Review Panel and may be discounted should the Panel determine the criterion was met without achieving the necessary performance level. For a win to count they must have been achieved in either a BWF or BEC sanctioned international competition.
- 2.4. For those did not meet the minimum results based criteria, the Panel will also take into consideration the following criterions to trigger a discussion at the Review Meeting.
- 2.4.1. Player's track record, current performance level at the discretion of the expert Panel
- 2.4.2. Player's ongoing commitment to pursue their badminton career
- 2.4.3. Player's foundation, skills & attributions in physical, technical & tactical areas
- 2.4.4. Player's extenuating circumstances including but not limited to significant injury and/or illness

3. Player Review Meeting

3.1. The England Performance Programme Review is scheduled for Apr/May 2024.

4. Player Review Process

- 4.1. The Review Panel's sole focus will be on the purpose of the England Performance Programme: 'To create an environment which develops and delivers courageous World Class Players from Talent to Top 10 who can build on our history of representing England and GB'.
- 4.2. To be able to deliver the above, the below 3 key principles will be applied across the Performance Pathway:
- 4.2.1. The focus will be on the long-term primary goal even if on occasions this may compromise short-term success.
- 4.2.2. The aim from the outset will be to develop rounded athletes with the necessary skills and attributes of both an athlete and a person.
- 4.2.3. Athletes will be developed based on a clear syllabus aligned to their individual development.







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- 4.3. The Review Panel will have an 'agile' approach to selection of players on the programme with a combination of objective and subjective criteria. This allows the expert Panel's view to see potential rather than being held by a purely objective results-based method.
- 4.4. The Review Panel will look at the mapping of each players performances over the period from 1st May 2023 through to 1st April 2024. In addition to this the England Coaching team and the Multi-Disciplinary Team will provide additional commentary on the development and progression of players throughout the stated period.
- 4.5. It is worth noting that the Performance structure requires those players invited onto Development & Futures level to have a connection to the National Badminton Centre (NBC), be it on a full-time basis, or agreed part-time basis, running parallel to pursuing their educational studies if relevant.
- 4.6. For those players moving into Badminton England's top tier National Squad based on criteria, the preferred training base of choice will always be the NBC where we are able to ensure that world-leading support on and off the court can be provided. However, if a player chooses to train outside of the NBC whilst maintaining and developing their performance level, they will receive full tournament support and Sport Science Sport Medicine support.

5. Review Outcomes

- 5.1. Following the Review meeting the Panel will deliberate and confirm in writing the outcome of the Review no later than 48hrs post the review meeting.
- 5.2. The outcome for each player reviewed will be one of the following:
- 5.2.1. Continuance on the England Performance Programme
- 5.2.2. Removal from the England Performance Programme*
- 5.2.3. Offer of a place on the England Performance Programme
- 5.2.4. Offer of opportunities to access the England Performance Training environment at the National Badminton Centre (NBC)
- *Note: A player removed from the EPP may be offered the opportunity to continue to access the EPP environment through discussion.
- 5.3. Following the Review meeting, each player reviewed will have the opportunity to meet with a member of the National Coaching Team to discuss and agree plans and support in respect to their outcome.
- 5.4. Please be advised that the decision of the Review Panel will be final and there will be no opportunity to appeal.

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6. Timetable for implementation of decisions from the Player Review

6.1. The decisions taken by the Review Panel will formally come into effect from the 1st April 2024. However, in consultation with each player particularly when there is a change in circumstance, we will develop a transition plan in preparation for that player.
