ELIGIBILITY FOR INVITATION TO LEGACY MATCH

Players are eligible for invitation based on meeting the following:

- Have competed in own age group domestic Gold tournament during the defined period for the Camp invite (where relevant)
- Hold a UK passport or a current resident of, and will have been resident in England for a minimum
 of 3 years (to be evidenced) at some point during the upcoming Programme year ending 30th June
 2025 (i.e., been a permanent resident in England since at least June 2022)*

*N.B the EJPP Team can at their discretion, choose to invite additional players into a Camp who do not necessarily meet the second bullet point above, however they consider that the player will significantly benefit those invited to attend based on the rankings criteria below. Players who do not meet the above two bullet points will however not be eligible for invite to an EJPP international tournament.
